

# Beach Rules

## Voyager Bay Scout camp

- 1) NO ONE is allowed to enter the beach without the permission of a lifeguard or lifeguard designee
- 2) NO ONE is allowed in the water without a buddy and a buddy tag on the board  
ONLY YOU are allowed to touch your buddy tag
- 3) Always stay close to your buddy
- 4) NEVER go outside of your ability area
- 5) When a buddy check is blown IMMEDIATELY get with your buddy and remain SILENT until the buddy check is over
- 6) ALWAYS remove your buddy tag from the buddy board BEFORE leaving the beach  
ONLY YOU are allowed to touch your buddy tag
- 7) During merit badge periods only scouts participating in merit badges taking place on the beach are allowed to enter the beach
- 8) Take ALL of your belongings every time you leave the beach
- 9) Only swimmers are allowed to take boats and canoes out
- 10) You must remain within the designated boating area while in a boat
- 11) You must remain outside the swimming area while in a boat
- 12) When on the water in a boat you must wear a life jacket at all times.
- 13) When a lifeguard or other qualified adult calls any one out of the water for any reason that means get out of the water as quickly and quietly as possible
- 14) DO NOT distract the lifeguards as you are not only risking your own safety but the safety of the others around you
- 15) NO BOYS are allowed on the adult swim raft ( the blue one)
- 16) You should not be outside the buoyed area for any reason.
- 17) There is no shoving off the ladder side of the raft.
- 18) NO sitting on any lawn chairs that might be on the beach they are for ADULTS ONLY
- 19) DO NOT play with the lifeguard equipment, this includes rescue tubes, ring buoys, poles, or any other equipment it is stored the way it is so that it can be accessed quickly.
- 20) Use common sense; this is the simplest but most important rule. If it seems like it might be a bad idea that it probably is.
