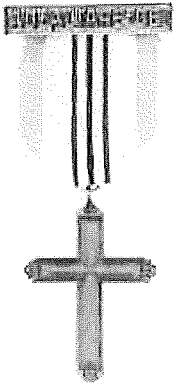


Ad Altare Dei



About The Emblem

The purpose of the Ad Altare Dei (to the altar of God) program is to help Catholic Scouts of the Roman Rite develop a fully Christian way of life in the faith community. The program is organized in chapters based on the seven Sacraments. The seven Sacraments are a primary means toward spiritual growth.

We will be offering the Ad Altare Dei program this year with Troop 342. Scouts who wish to participate in the program must meet the following requirements:

- Be Catholic
- Active in their troop
- Completed 6th grade
- Obtain signatures to begin the program from a parent, the emblem counselor, scoutmaster and pastor.

The program lasts approximately 6 months. Scouts will be required to attend 1 1/2 hour sessions twice a month. Parents will be required to assist at least once, so that 2-deep leadership is always maintained. After completing the sessions, scouts will meet with a religious emblem board of review. The program concludes with a ceremony to present the medal.
